THE IDEAL COMBINATION The Maricat 4.3 m is a very versatile catamaran, being an ideal boat for family fun yet as it comes standard it has all the "go fast" gear fitted to make it a top racing catamaran in the 14ft. division.

CRUISING COMFORT Your safety and comfort are well catered for. Saddle sores are a thing of the past when you sit on the Maricat 4.3 m. The trampoline joins smoothly into the curved fibreglass decks and provides comfortable seating whether you are pottering along in a drifter, or straining to hold down a hull on a screaming reach. A righting rope is of course standard equipment, should you hole a hull, styrene foam filled hulls will keep your boat afloat. As well as having sufficient buoyancy to cruise in comfort with 2-3 people, features such as storage lockers in each hull, and the natural stability of the Maricat 4.3 m have helped to make it Australia's largest selling 14 ft. catamaran.

RACING The expensive go fast options offered on other craft are standard equipment on the Maricat 4.3 m. Full width roller traveller, six block mainsheet, geared downhaul, boom vang, loose footed sail, etc., are not an expensive afterthought you will need to buy later. The Maricat 4.3 m has an impressive racing record, in the 14 ft. division, having many major regatta wins to its credit. It is regarded as being one of the fastest production 14 footers. The Maricat 4.3 m can be raced one up cat rigged, or two up with the new efficient racing jib.

ASSOCIATION The basis of the strength of the Maricat class is the very strong national and state associations. The activities of these associations range from providing basic tuition to newcomers to the sport, picnic cruises, social activities, racing events, through to state and national title events.



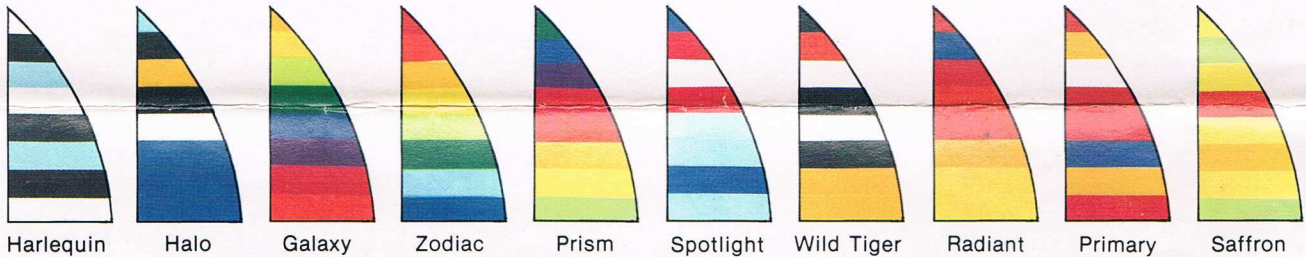
Maricat 4.3 m with jib showing her paces.

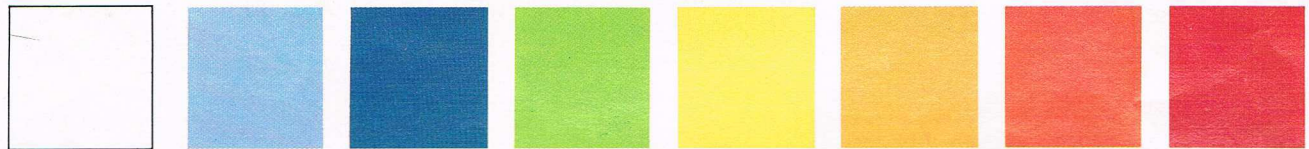

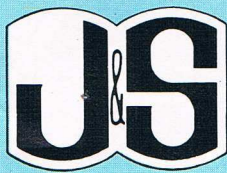
